(1) (Lk 22:31-32)

31 "Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat.

32 But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

(3) (Ac 24:16)

16 So I strive always to keep my conscience clear before God and man.

(4) (Jn 20:21)

21 Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

(4) (2Sa 12:9-12)

9 Why did you despise the word of the LORD by doing what is evil in his eyes? You struck down Uriah the Hittite with the sword and took his wife to be your own. You killed him with the sword of the Ammonites.

10 Now, therefore, the sword will never depart from your house, because you despised me and took the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your own."

11 "This is what the LORD says: 'Out of your own household I am going to bring calamity upon you. Before your very eyes I will take your wives and give them to one who is close to you, and he will lie with your wives in broad daylight.

12 You did it in secret, but I will do this thing in broad daylight before all Israel.'" (Isa 6:7-10)

7 With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."

8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

9 He said, "Go and tell this people: "'Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.'"

10 Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed." (Jn 8:26)

26 "I have much to say in judgment of you. But he who sent me is reliable, and what I have heard from him I tell the world."

(5) (Ro 10:17)

17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

(10) (Ac 13:22)

22 After removing Saul, he made David their king. He testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.'

(2) (Ac 2:41-42)

41 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

(3) (Lk 24:49)

49 I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

(4) (Jn 5:30)

30 By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.
